BOUTEFLIKA CALLS FOR DEBT RESTRUCTURING AND WORLDWIDE PRODUCTIVE EFFORT AT UN

SEPT. 3 (IPS)--ADDRESSING THE OPENING SESSION OF THE UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY, ALGERIAN FOREIGN MINISTER ABDELAZIZ BOUFLIKA CALLED ON THE ADVANCED SECTOR TO HELP SOLVE THE URGENT ECONOMIC CRISIS FACING THE THIRD WORLD AND STRESSED THE NEED FOR THE DEVELOPED COUNTRIES TO IMMEDIATELY INCREASE THEIR EXPORTABLE FOOD SURPLUS, "BY USING ALL AVAILABLE MEANS OF PRODUCTION."

"IT WOULD BE PERFECTLY POSSIBLE TO REALIZE SUCH A GOAL IF THE DEVELOPED COUNTRIES DECIDED AT LAST TO WORK TOWARDS IT, LEAVING ASIDE ANY POLITICAL CONSIDERATIONS AND USING THEIR TECHNOLOGICAL CAPACITY AND THEIR RESOURCES INCLUDING THOSE WHICH MIGHT BE RELEASED BY DISARMAMENT.... ACCESS TO FOOD IS INDISSOLUBLY LINKED WITH THE RIGHT TO LIFE. ANY PRESSURE DESIGNED TO LIMIT THIS RIGHT AND ANY ATTEMPT TO USE THE THREAT OF FAMINES AS BLACKMAIL WOULD CONSTITUTE A SERIOUS VIOLATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS."

BOUFLIKA IDENTIFIED THE CRUSHING BURDEN OF DEBT THREATENING THE THIRD, WORLD, AND ATTACKED THE INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL COMMUNITY. URGING "SERIOUS RENEGOTIATION...OF THE CUMULATIVE DEBT BURDEN OF THE COUNTRIES OF THE THIRD WORLD," BOUFLIKA CALLED FOR INDUSTRIALIZATION OF THE UNDERDEVELOPED SECTOR AND CLOSED BY ASKING, "IS IT OVERLY IDEALISTIC TO INVITE THE RICH COUNTRIES TO PUT ASIDE THEIR EGOISM AND THEIR ACCUSTOMED PRACTICES, IN ORDER TO RECONCILE THEIR TRUE INTEREST WITH THE ASPIRATIONS OF ALL MANKIND FOR PEACE, FREEDOM AND WELL-BEING?"

INDONESIA PROCLAIMS COLLAPSE OF BRETTON WOODS, CALLS ON EUROPEANS, JAPANESE TO JOIN WITH EAST BLOC IN DEVELOPMENT

UNITED NATIONS, SEPT. 2 (IPS)--DECLARING HIS COMPLETE SOLIDARITY WITH ALGERIAN PRESIDENT BOUMEDIENE'S PROGRAMMATIC THRUST FOR A NEW WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER, INDONESIA FOREIGN MINISTER ADAM MALIK IN HIS SPEECH TO THE UNITED NATIONS SPECIAL SESSION TODAY OUTLINED THE COLLAPSE OF THE BRETTON WOODS SYSTEM, THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE CURRENT BREAKDOWN CRISIS, AND THEN INTERVENED INTO THE CURRENT FACTIONAL SITUATION IN EUROPE AND JAPAN BY DEMANDING THAT PRO-DEVELOPMENT FORCES THERE JOIN WITH THE THIRD WORLD AND THE SOVIET BLOC FOR TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT.

"THE PRESENT INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC SYSTEM," HE STATED, "HAS SHOWN ITSELF...INCAPABLE OF EVEN FUNCTIONING PROPERLY.... WE ARE NOT CONCERNED WITH A TEMPORARY BREAKDOWN OR STAGNATION, ... THAT MAY BE OVERCOME BY PATCHWORK...(BUT) WITH A STRUCTURAL CRISIS OF THE SYSTEM THAT WILL REQUIRE INTEGRAL REFORM AND RECONSTRUCTION."

PRAISING STEPS ALREADY TAKEN TO EXPAND TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT, MALIK URGED THAT COOPERATION "BETWEEN" STATES IRRESPECTIVE OF THEIR ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL SYSTEMS" BE INCREASED.

MR. MALIK FURTHER STRESSED THAT "...WHEN WE SPEAK OF REDEPLOYMENT OF INDUSTRY, IT SHOULD BE MADE CLEAR THAT THERE IS NO QUESTION OF CLOSING DOWN FACTORIES IN ORDER TO TRANSFER THEM TO THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES. REDEPLOYMENT CAN ONLY RELATE TO NEW PRODUCTION POSSIBILITIES TO BE CREATED, PREFERABLY IN THESE COUNTRIES."

TODENHOEFER BACKS SELECTIVE DEBT MORATORIUM FOR THIRD AND FOURTH WORLD

BONN, BRD, SEPT. 3 (IPS)—JUERGEN TODENHOEFER, THE DEVELOPMENT POLICY SPOKESMAN OF THE WEST GERMAN OPPOSITION PARTY, THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION, ADVOCATED DEBT MORATORIA "FOR FOURTH WORLD COUNTRIES IN GENERAL, AND FOR SOME COUNTRIES OF THE THIRD WORLD IN WHICH THE SITUATION IS CATASTROPHIC, SUCH AS INDIA" IN AN INTERVIEW WITH IPS LAST NIGHT. TODENHOEFER ADDED THAT HE HAD DISCUSSED THIS WITH ROBERT MCNAMARA, PRESIDENT OF THE WORLD BANK WHO THOROUGHLY DISAGREED WITH THE IDEA OF DEBT MORATORIA. "IT IS RIDICULOUS," TODENHOEFER ADDED, "WHEN WE GIVE THEM A 300 MILLION MARK CREDIT AND THEY ONLY PAY BACK THE INTEREST ON THE DEBT."

"MODERATE" ANTUNES, "MAOIST" CARVALHO, AND FABIAO UNITE IN ANTI-GONCALVES MOVES

SEPT. 3 (IPS)—BOTH "MODERATE" MAJOR MELO ANTUNES, DESIGNER OF THE FAILED COUP ATTEMPT LAST WEEK, AND MAOIST GENERAL OTELO CARVALHO, ATTENDED GENERAL CARLOS FABIAO'S PRE-ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) ASSEMBLY FACTION MEETING YESTERDAY IN TANCOS, ACCORDING TO NEUES DEUTSCHLAND THE PAPER OF THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY. IT WAS AT THIS MEETING THAT "RIGHTIST FORCES WITHIN THE ARMED FORCES WERE TRYING TO ALTER THE COMPOSITION OF THE ASSEMBLY," BY PURGING PROGRESSIVES, REPORTS THE PAPER.

ACCORDING TO MILITARY SOURCES, PRO-NATO ARMY UNITS ARE NOW THREATENING TO BOYCOTT THE FRIDAY MFA ASSEMBLY IF GONCALVES IS NOT REMOVED AS CHIEF OF THE ARMED FORCES, ACCORDING TO UPI TODAY. IT APPEARS THAT THESE UNITS FEAR THAT THEY WILL LOSE THE ELECTIONS FOR DELEGATES, DESPITE THEIR ON-GOING FACTIONAL MACHINATIONS.

GENSCHER TAGGED AS STATE DEPT. AGENT BY W. GERMAN PRESS

WIESBADEN, BRD, SEPT. 3 (IPS)--REFERRING TO YESTERDAY'S UNITED NATIONS SPEECH BY WEST GERMAN FOREIGN MINISTER HANS-DIETRICH GENSCHER, FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAU CORRESPONDENT MONIKA METZNER COMMENTED IN TODAY'S ISSUE THAT "THE WEST GERMAN POSITION, WHICH WAS WORKED OUT IN CONTACT WITH THE U.S.A., WAS FUNDAMENTALLY THAT OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT." THE COVERAGE COUNTERPOSES GENSCHER'S SPEECH WITH THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT SPEECH OF ALGERIAN FOREIGN MINISTER BOUTEFLIKA.

PRO-SOVIET CHINESE REVOLUTION EXPANDS: MAOISTS FREAK OUT

NEW YORK, SEPT. 3 (IPS)--THE STRENGTH OF THE PRO-SOVIET REVOLUTION IN CHINA HAS REACHED SUCH INTENSITY THAT THE MAOIST LEADERSHIP OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY HAS BEEN FORCED TO LAUNCH A MAJOR CAMPAIGN AGAINST ALLEGED "CAPITULATIONISTS" IN THE PARTY WHO FAVOR RAPPROCHEMENT WITH THE SOVIET UNION, ACCORDING TO NUMEROUS ACCOUNTS IN THE WESTERN PRESS. THE NEW CAMPAIGN HAS BEEN PLASTERED ALL OVER THE PARTY NEWSPAPER PEOPLE'S DAILY AND THE THEORETICAL ORGAN RED FLAG, AND WAS KEYNOTED BY A MAJOR ARTICLE BY THE TOP MAOIST PROPAGANDIST, YAO WEN-YUAN. THE INTENSITY OF THE CAMPAIGN DEMONSTRATES THAT THE STRIKE WAVE WITHIN THE WORKING CLASS AND SIGNIFICANT LAYERS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY ITSELF HAS DEVELOPED BOTH ORGANIZATION AND LEADERSHIP FROM TOP CIRCLES WITHIN THE PARTY.

CHICAGO JUDGE REVIVES 30'S STRIKE-BREAKING PLOY
IN KRESGE STRIKE

SEPT. 3 (IPS)--REVIVING STRIKE-BREAKING TACTICS FROM THE 1930'S, CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE MILLER IN CHICAGO IMPOSED A \$1000 PEACE BOND ON FIVE LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS ARRESTED AT THE ROSELAND KRESGE STORE YESTERDAY. THE BOND RESTRICTS THE USLP'ERS RIGHT TO PICKET.

THE ARREST WAS SET UP BY THE KRESGE STORE MANAGER WHO PAID A LOCAL THUG, DWIGHT LOW, TO ORGANIZE A GANG OF YOUTH TO ATTACK THE LABOR PARTY PICKETERS WHEN THEY ARRIVED AT THE STORE. WHEN THE LABOR PARTY SUMMONED POLICE THE ASSAILANTS WERE ALL RELEASED AND THE 5 ORGANIZERS CHARGED WITH DISTURBING THE PEACE. THE LABOR PARTY ORGANIZERS WERE FORCED TO SIGN THE PEACE BOND WHEN JUDGE MILLER TOLD THEM: "SIGN THE BOND OR YOU GO TO JAIL NOW."
