I. INTERNATIONAL

PORTUGUESE COMMUNISTS ORGANIZING IN BACKWARD FARM AREAS

OCT. 23 (IPS)--IN PORTALEGRE, A BACKWARD AND ISOLATED AREA IN CENTRAL PORTUGAL, THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) HAS HELD A MEETING WITH FARMERS AND FARMWORKERS, TO PLAN THE RE-INVESTMENT OF AGRO-SURPLUS TO IMPROVE THE LIVING CONDITIONS OF THE WORKERS. THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE MEETING SPECIFICALLY DEMANDED THAT THE GOVERNMENT IMMEDIATELY RELEASE FARM CREDITS TO EXPAND SOCIAL SERVICES AND MAKE SUCH REINVESTMENT POSSIBLE. THEY ALSO DEMANDED THAT TECHNICIANS BE BROUGHT INTO THE AREA. INVESTMENT WILL BE USED FOR MACHINERY, IMPROVED SEEDS AND FERTILIZER, AND FOR IRRIGATION PROJECTS. ONE WORKER STATED: "AGRARIAN REFORM WILL NOT BE STALLED, EVEN IF SOME OF US MUST LOSE OUR LIVES," REPORTS THE LISBON DAILY DIARIO DE NOTICIAS OCT. 20.

PCOE SAYS CARILLO MEANS DEMOCRATIC FACE FOR FASCISM

OCT. 22 (IPS)--THE LATEST ISSUE OF THE ENRIQUE LISTER-LED SPANISH WORKERS COMMUNIST PARTY'S NEWSPAPER MUNDO OBRERO ACCUSES SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER SANTIAGO CARRILLO'S DEMOCRATIC JUNTA OF "CAPITALIZING ON EXECUTED TERRORISTS' BLOOD." THE JUNTA'S ALTERNATIVE, SAYS MUNDO OBRERO, "MEANS TO GIVE A 'DEMOCRATIC FACE' TO THE CONTINUATION OF THE REACTION.

IN ITS FIGHT AGAINST CLASS 'RECONCILIATION,' THE PCOE CALLS UPON "ALL TRUE ANTI-FRANCO FORCES" TO "THOROUGHLY LIQUIDATE FRANCO'S REGIME," THE ARTICLE SAID. THE PCOE EMPHASIZED THE FIGHT AGAINST ALL KINDS OF "BOURGEOIS PSEUDO-ALTERNATIVES" IN ORDER "TO DISARM FASCIST COUNTERREVOLUTION" DURING THE PROCESS OF CREATING A 'WORKERS REPUBLIC WITH OPEN DOORS TO SOCIALISM.'

SPINOLA ARRIVAL IN MADRID?

OCT. 22 (IPS)--THIS WEEK'S PORTUGUESE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC NEWSPAPER, ESPRESSO, REPORTS THE POSSIBLE ARRIVAL IN MADRID OF THE FASCIST GENERAL ANTONIO DE SPINOLA THIS FRIDAY. A SPINOLA SPOKESMAN SUBSEQUENTLY DENIED THE ESPRESSO REPORT HOWEVER. SPINOLA IS A CLOSE PROTEGE OF THE ROCKEFELLER FAMILY'S SUPRANATIONAL FRONT, THE BILDERBURG GROUP, AND CURRENTLY RESIDES IN BRAZIL.

DIE WELT TRIES TO SAVE LEBER

OCT. 22 (IPS)--THE WEST GERMAN RIGHT WING DAILY DIE WELT TODAY BLAMED THE SCANDAL OF A MYSTERIOUS UNDERCOVER VISIT TO SOUTH AFRICA BY A LEADING WEST GERMAN AIR FORCE GENERAL RALL ON A "COMMUNIST" TAKEOVER OF THE AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS, WHICH ALLEGEDLY BEGAN A CAMPAIGN AGAINST SOUTH AFRICA AND WEST GERMANY AS SOON AS NON-COMMUNISTS WERE "PURGED." THE SCANDAL, WHICH HAS ALREADY FORCED THE RESIGNATION OF WEST GERMAN AIR FORCE GENERAL RALL, MAY ALSO LEAD TO THE FORCED RESIGNATION OF WEST GERMAN DEFENCE MINISTER -- AND ROCKEFELLER AGENT -- GEORG LEBER.

DIE WELT OUTLINES THE AFRICAN NATIONAL CONGRESS'S TIES TO EAST GERMANY, AND CLAIMS THAT THE ANC IS NOW EXCLUDING "PROPO- NENTS OF PURE AFRICAN NATIONALISM." THIS WAS THE REASON FOR RALL'S VISIT, SAYS DIE WELT. LAST WEEK, DIE WELT STATED OPENLY THAT "IF LEBER RESIGNS, THEN IT IS AN ATTACK ON THE ATLANTIC ALLIANCE."

SCHMIDT-WALLACE MEETING BLOCKED BY SCHMIDT'S OWN PARTY

WIESBADEN, BRD, OCT. 23 (IPS) -- A MEETING BETWEEN WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT AND ROCKEFELLER PLENIPOTENTIARY GEORGE WALLACE WAS ONLY PREVENTED BY PRESSURE FROM "SCHMIDT'S OWN PARTY," ACCORDING TO WASHINGTON POST BONN CORRESPONDENT MICHAEL GETLER.

WHILE THE REPORT ONLY REFERRED TO GENERAL UNREST IN THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD) OVER SCHMIDT'S RIGHT WING POLICIES, THE HAMBURG DAILY DIE WELT CONTINUES ITS INTIMATIONS THAT SCHMIDT IS PRESENTLY HEAVILY UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF SPD VICE- CHAIRMAN HERBERT WEHNER. DIE WELT MAKES SPECIAL MENTION OF THE FACT THAT SCHMIDT WILL SIT RIGHT BESIDE WEHNER AT TODAY'S PARLIAMENTARY FRACTION MEETING. THE CHANCELLOR IN AN UNPRECEDENTED MOVE, RE- FUSED TO MEET WITH SPD CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT BEFOREHAND.

DREGGER CALLS FOR GERMAN GOVERNMENT TO RESIGN

OCT. 23 (IPS) -- "IF THE WEST GERMAN GOVERNMENT DOES NOT KNOW HOW TO CARRY OUT AUSTERITY MEASURES, IT SHOULD RESIGN," STATED ALFRED DREGGER, CHAIRMAN OF THE HESSEN STATE BRANCH OF THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION AND A POLITICAL ALLY OF RIGHT-WING NATO POLITICIAN FRANZ JOSEF STRAUSS OF THE CHRISTIAN SOCIAL UNION (CSU).

THE CALL BY DREGGER, MADE AT A MASS CSU RALLY IN MUNICH, WAS REPORTED IN THE SUEDEDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG YESTERDAY, AND REPRESENTS THE FIRST TIME THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC-FREE DEMOCRATIC GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN CHALLENGED TO RESIGN DURING WEST GERMANY'S CURRENT ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL CRISIS.

LEYLAND SENDS HOME 600 WORKERS FOR LOW PRODUCTION

OCT. 23 (IPS) -- BRITISH LEYLAND, THE LARGEST PRIVATE EMPLOYER IN BRITAIN, SENT HOME 600 AUTOWORKERS FOR ONE WEEK ON OCT. 21 BECAUSE OF THEIR "ABYSMALLY LOW PRODUCTION," REPORTS THE LONDON TIMES. LEYLAND MANAGEMENT, WHICH IS NEGOTIATING A "RATIONALIZATION" PROGRAM WITH THE UNIONS TO FIRE 22,000 WORKERS NATIONWIDE, IS OPENLY THREATENING LOW PRODUCERS WITH UNEMPLOYMENT. WORKERS AT THE PLANTS ASSERT THAT LOWER PRODUCTIVITY FIGURES ARE THE RESULT OF ASSEMBLY-LINE BREAK-DOWNS AND COMPONENT SHORTAGES DUE TO NON-REPLACEMENT OF OBSOLETE EQUIPMENT.

OPPENHEIMER FORESEES SOUTH AFRICAN TERRORISM AND ITS BENEFITS

OCT. 23 (IPS) -- TERRORISM MAY VERY WELL CROP UP IN SOUTH AFRICA, ACCORDING TO THE AUGUST ISSUE OF MANAGEMENT, A MAGAZINE CONTROLLED BY ROCKEFELLER'S CHIEF ALLY IN SOUTH AFRICA, HARRY F. OPPENHEIMER. "EVERY SITUATION THROWS UP ITS OWN OPPORTUNITIES (HOWEVER)... IN NORTHERN IRELAND, DISTURBANCES HAVE PRODUCED A WAR PSYCHOLOGY... PRODUCTIVITY TENDS TO GO UP AND STRIKES, STOPPAGES AND DISPUTES DECLINE. THE RISING PRODUCTIVITY OF NORTHERN IRELAND WORKERS HAS BECOME A MAIN SELLING POINT." THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE MAGAZINE'S EDITORIAL ADVISORY BOARD, DR. SIMON BIESHEUVEL, IS A PROTEGE OF THE NOTORIOUS BRAINWASHER DR. JOHN RAWLINGS REES, AND OBSERVERS NOTE, A MAN CAPABLE OF ARRANGING FOR "TERRORISM."

TETHER WARNS THAT INTERNATIONAL MONETARY CRISIS JUST BEGINNING

OCT. 23 (IPS) -- C. GORDON TETHER, COLUMNIST FOR THE LONDON FINANCIAL TIMES, WARNS IN HIS COLUMN TODAY THAT THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF BALANCE OF PAYMENT SURPLUSES IN SOME RICH COUNTRIES LIKE THE U.S. AND CANADA "MEANS THAT THE WHOLE OF THE INTERNATIONAL BURDEN ARISING FROM THE OIL COUNTRIES' SURPLUS IS BEING BORNE BY MEDIUM AND LIGHT-WEIGHT AFFLUENT STATES AND THE THIRD WORLD -- A SITUATION THAT OBVIOUSLY CANNOT ENDURE FOR MORE THAN A FEW MONTHS." WHILE IT HAS BEEN THOUGHT THAT THE RECENT ECONOMIC CALM PORTENDS A RETURN TO STABILITY, TETHER WARNS THAT "A CLOSER LOOK MIGHT APPEAR TO INDICATE THAT IT HASN'T EVEN STARTED."

OCT. 23 (IPS) -- IN A PRESS STATEMENT TO CBS AFFILIATE, RADIO KCBS IN SAN FRANCISCO OCT. 21, FORMER FEDERAL AGENT ROY FRANKHAUSER EXPOSED THE MEANING OF ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWARD LEVI'S STATED INTENTION TO PUT THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT'S "HOUSE IN ORDER."

"THIS MEANS MORE BRAINWASHING AND MANIPULATION OF THE TYPE WE'VE SEEN IN THE PATTY HEARST CASE," FRANKHAUSER SAID.

FRANKHAUSER CHARGED THAT THE METHODS BEING USED AGAINST HEARST ARE TYPICAL JUSTICE DEPARTMENT ILLEGAL FRAME-UP TECHNIQUES. HER CONVERSATIONS WITH VISITING "FRIENDS" IN JAIL HAVE BEEN TAPED TO ACCUMULATE EVIDENCE THAT CAN BE USED AGAINST HER. SHE IS BEING KEPT IN A CONTROLLED "AVERSIVE ENVIRONMENT," IN A "BUGGED" CELL OPPOSITE THE CELL OF HER SLA CONTROLLER EMILY HARRIS. MISS HEARST HAS ALSO BEEN ISOLATED FROM HER PARENTS, WHOSE ANXIETIES ARE BEING MANIPULATED TO RAILROAD THE CASE AND SUPPRESS TESTIMONY ON THE GOVERNMENT'S SLA BRAINWASHING AND TERROR OPERATION.

BALTIMORE SUN ENDORSES EXPANDED USE OF HALLUCINOGENS;
FOLLOWS DOMESTIC COUNCIL THRUST FOR DECRIMINALIZATION

OCT. 23 (IPS) — FOLLOWING THE RECENTLY-RELEASED DOMESTIC COUNCIL RECOMMENDATIONS FOR "DECRIMINALIZATION" OF SO-CALLED "SOFT DRUGS," THE OCT. 21 BALTIMORE SUN ISSUED AN EDITORIAL ENDORSEMENT OF "SCIENTIFIC" RESEARCH" AND USE OF LSD-DRUGS IN TREATING ALCOHOLISM, OTHER DRUG ADDICTION, AND PSYCHOLOGICAL DISORDERS. THE DOMESTIC COUNCIL RECOMMENDATIONS HAVE BEEN ACCOMPANIED BY "REVIVED INTEREST" IN HALLUCINOGENS IN THE PRESS MORE GENERALLY AMOUNTING TO A CAMPAIGN TO PROMOTE THEIR USE.

HONDURANS DENOUNCE SALVADORIAN BORDER TENSION

OCT. 23 (IPS) — THE INFORMATION MINISTER OF HONDURAS, LT. COL. EFRAIN GONZALEZ, HAS ACCUSED THE SALVADORIAN GOVERNMENT OF DEPLOYING TROOPS TO ITS BORDER AND EVACUATING CITIZENS LAST THURSDAY NIGHT, TO INCREASE THE TENSION ALREADY EXISTING BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. ACCORDING TO THE DIARIO LAS AMERICAS YESTERDAY, GONZALEZ ATTRIBUTED THE MOVES OF THE SALVADORIANS TO "INTERNAL PROBLEMS," NOTABLY, EXPANDED COMMUNIST ORGANIZING AND DIVISION WITHIN ITS MILITARY. HONDURAN PRO-PEASANT LAND REFORMS AND A PRO-DEVELOPMENT POLICY AGGRAVATED SUCH SALVADORIAN "PROBLEMS."

HERE, EVEN SMALL PROJECTS HAVE TO GO THROUGH STATE AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CHANNELS, BEFORE THERE IS EVEN AGREEMENT TO BEGIN A STUDY."

EQUALLY IMPRESSIVE TO BURLEIGH: "SOVIET SCHOOLS ARE TURNING OUT A LARGE NUMBER (OF EDUCATED ENGINEERS) EVERY YEAR." BURLEIGH POINTS OUT THAT THE TEXAS WATER IMPORT PLAN WAS VETOED IN 1972 BECAUSE OF ITS MERE \$9 BILLION COST. EVEN SMALLER IRRIGATION PROJECTS COULD NOT BE COUNTED ON, BECAUSE THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT REFUSES TO MAKE A STABLE COMMITMENT TO FOOD PRODUCTION FOR EXPORTS, HE CLAIMED.

**BUFFALO ELECTION COMMISSION CHAIRMAN CONTINUES
EFFORT TO DUMP USLP FROM BALLOT**

BUFFALO, OCT. 23 (IPS) -- EDWARD MAHONEY, CHAIRMAN OF THE BUFFALO BOARD OF ELECTIONS TODAY EMPLOYED A BIZARRE INTERPRETATION OF NEW YORK STATE ELECTION LAW IN RULING THAT APPROXIMATELY 2000 OF 2900 NOMINATING SIGNATURES FOR FOUR U.S. LABOR PARTY CANDIDATES HERE WERE INVALID. IF MAHONEY'S RULING, HIS THIRD ATTEMPT TO MANUFACTURE GROUNDS TO EXCLUDE THE USLP FROM THE BALLOT, IS UPHELD BY THE COURTS, THE FOUR, COUNTY EXECUTIVE CANDIDATE ROGER MOORE, CITY CONTROLLER CANDIDATE JOSEPH FISCH, AND COUNCIL-MAN-AT-LARGE CANDIDATE STUART FOLADARE AND RICHARD DENESHA WILL NOT APPEAR ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT.

MAHONEY, ISSUING A RULING WHICH HE HIMSELF ADMITTED WAS WITHOUT PRECEDENT, HELD THAT BECAUSE THE 2000 SIGNERS HAD SUBSEQUENTLY CAST BALLOTS IN PRIMARY ELECTIONS LAST MONTH -- TECHNICALLY CASTING TWO VOTES -- THEIR NOMINATING SIGNATURES WERE INVALID.

BUT FLABBERGASTED ELECTION LAWYERS HERE SAY THAT, ACCORDING TO STATE CASE LAW, MAHONEY HAS ACTUALLY PROVIDED GROUNDS TO INVALIDATE THE RESULTS OF SEVERAL PRIMARY ACES; THE LAW, THEY SAY, IS CLEAR THAT IF A PERSON INDICATES TWO PREFERENCES FOR THE SAME RACE, THE FIRST ONE COUNTS. IN THE USLP CASE, ALL OF THE 2000 CONTESTED SIGNATURES WERE OBTAINED BEFORE THE PRIMARY. USLP ATTORNEYS WILL GO INTO COURT NEXT WEEK TO SEEK A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER PLACING THE USLP CANDIDATES ON THE BALLOT, PENDING A FINAL COURT REVIEW, WHICH, THEY SAY, MUST FAVOR THE LABOR PARTY PROVIDED THE COURTS UPHOLD THE LAW.

MEANWHILE, DEMOCRAT MAHONEY HAS GIVEN INCUMBENT COUNTY EXECUTIVE ED REAGAN, A REPUBLICAN, LEAA AGENT, AND LOCAL ROCKEFELLER MACHINE LEADER, A SECOND BALLOT LINE, AS THE CANDIDATE OF THE ERSATZ "WORKING PERSONS PARTY." SOURCES IN THE LOCAL CONSERVATIVE PARTY HAVE TOLD THE USLP THAT REAGAN, WHO ALSO INTRODUCED METHADONE ADDICTION TO THE BUFFALO AREA, WILL GET THE SUPPORT OF MAHONEY'S DEMOCRATIC MACHINE THROUGH HIS ERSATZ SECOND PARTY.
