MEXICAN PRESS BLOWS CIA TERRORIST OPERATIONS

MEXICO CITY, JULY 26 (IPS) — THE RECENTLY-EXPOSED CIA/FBI/LEAA INTERNATIONAL DRUG AND GUN RUNNING ACTIVITIES WERE GIVEN DETAILED COVERAGE IN THE MAJOR MEXICAN DAILIES OVACIONES AND LA PRENSA THIS MORNING AFTER REPORTERS FROM BOTH PAPERS ATTENDED A LATIN AMERICAN LABOR COMMITTEES (LALC) PRESS CONFERENCE ON THESE OPERATIONS IN MEXICO CITY YESTERDAY AFTERNOON.

LA PRENSA REPORTS LALC ALLEGATIONS THAT "ALL EXISTING TERRORIST GROUPS IN THE WORLD ARE CONTROLLED AND DIRECTED BY THE CIA, THE FBI AND THE LEAA, WHICH COUNT ON THE FINANCIAL SUPPORT OF THE ROCKEFELLER, FORD AND OTHER FOUNDATIONS THAT CONTROL THE WORLD ECONOMY. ALSO REPORTED WERE THE LINKS BETWEEN THE TERRORIST OPERATIONS AND HENRY KISSINGER'S NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL. KISSINGER COORDINATES A "GUN-RUNNING AND TERRORIST OPERATION TO PROVIDE GUNS TO TERRORIST ELEMENTS IN LEBANON, THROUGH THE COLT INDUSTRIES COMPANY OF HARTFORD, CONNECTICUT WHICH HAS CLOSE TIES TO THE CIA," SAID LA PRENSA.

A PAGE TWO OVACIONES ARTICLE BEGINS BY RECAPITULATING LALC CHARGES THAT NELSON ROCKEFELLER AND HENRY KISSINGER DIRECT WORLD DRUG AND EXPLOSIVES TRAFFIC.

BOTH NEWSPAPERS REPORT THE LALC DEMAND THAT MEXICAN ATTORNEY GENERAL PEDRO OJEDA PAULLADA FULLY INVESTIGATE THE CIA-LEAA-FBI OPERATIONS IN THIS COUNTRY.

ESTABLISHMENT OF PORTUGUESE TRIUMVIRATE A PCP VICTORY

JULY 26 (IPS) — A GROUP OF OFFICERS IN THE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) CLOSE TO THE PORTUGUESE SOCIALIST PARTY (PSP) HAS BEEN PURGED FROM EFFECTIVE INFLUENCE IN THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL. AT LAST NIGHT'S ASSEMBLY MEETING, THE MFA ESTABLISHED A THREE-MAN MILITARY JUNTA, INCLUDING PRIME MINISTER GONCALVES, PRESIDENT GOMES AND GENERAL CARVALHO. THIS TRIUMVIRATE REDUCES THE ROLE OF THE COUNCIL TO A MERE ADVISORY BODY, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE TRIO IS A "DEFEAT FOR THE LEADERSHIP OF THE PSP WHICH HAD CALLED FOR GONCALVES' ELIMINATION," REPORTS THIS WEEKEND'S FRENCH DAILY LE MONDE. THE WASHINGTON POST CONCEDES TODAY THAT "THE JUNTA PLAN REPRESENTS ANOTHER VICTORY FOR GONCALVES."

AGNELLI PRESSES FOR BRAZILIANIZATION OF EUROPE

JULY 26, (IPS) — FIAT OWNER AND TRILATERAL COMMISSION MEMBER GIANNI AGNELLI BELIEVES THAT THERE ARE TOO MANY FACTORIES IN THE INDUSTRIAL CONCENTRATIONS OF EUROPE SUCH AS THE RUHR, AT THE EXPENSE OF RELATIVELY UNDERDEVELOPED AREAS SUCH AS ITALY AND IRELAND. SPEAKING AT A DUBLIN MEETING SPONSORED BY THE FINANCIAL TIMES, AGNELLI PROPOSED A REDISTRIBUTION OF EUROPEAN INDUSTRY UNDERLINING THE MOBILITY OF ALL ELEMENTS OF PRODUCTION, ESPECIALLY MACHINERY AND LABOR. AGNELLI HAS ALREADY IMPLEMENTED HIS OWN SUGGESTION AND BEGUN MOVING SEVERAL FIAT FACTORIES TO BRAZIL. HIS REMARKS WERE REPORTED TODAY IN THE ITALIAN FINANCIAL PAPER IL FIORINO.

EGYPTIAN MAGAZINE PRAISES JOINT
IRAQ-EGYPT DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES

JULY 26 (IPS) — THE PAST YEAR HAS WITNESSED "THE DAILY GROWTH OF COOPERATION BETWEEN EGYPT AND IRAQ IN VARIOUS SPHERES," EGYPT'S LEFTIST MAGAZINE ROSE EL-YOUSSEF NOTED LAST WEEK. JULY 26 (IPS) — AT JOINT IRAQI-ALGERIAN ECONOMIC DISCUSSIONS IN ALGIERS LAST WEEKEND, IRAQI CHAIRMAN OF THE STATE ORGANIZATION FOR ENGINEERING INDUSTRIES ALI AL-HAMDANI RECOMMENDED ALGERIAN PARTICIPATION IN THE ARAB INDUSTRIAL INVESTMENT COMPANY, AT PRESENT AN IRAQI-EGYPTIAN VENTURE, ACCORDING TO THE JULY 21 BAGHDAD OBSERVER. THE TALKS, WHICH INCLUDED AN EGYPTIAN DELEGATION, WERE SUCCESSFUL, ACCORDING TO AL-HAMDANI, AND WILL BE FOLLOWED SOON BY ANOTHER ROUND.

U.S. LABOR PARTY TO COUNTERPUNCH KRESGE CORPORATION

NEW YORK, JULY 26 (IPS) — THE U.S. LABOR PARTY ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY THE BEGINNING OF A NATIONAL BOYCOTT CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE KRESGE-K-MART CHAIN AFTER CORPORATION OFFICIALS REFUSED TO ANSWER A USLP DEMAND THAT MANAGERS OF ALL RETAIL OUTLETS BE INSTRUCTED BY THE COMPANY TO STOP ILLEGAL HARASSMENT OF THE USLP LAROUCHE-EVANS PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN. THE CAMPAIGN WILL TARGET THE MOST VULNERABLE OUTLETS IN AREAS OF HIGH LABOR PARTY PENETRATION.

THE USLP WAS TO BE INFORMED OF KRESGE'S COMPLIANCE WITH THE DEMAND BY NOON TODAY.

FLOODS IN BRAZIL

JULY 26 (IPS) — THE HEAVIEST FLOODING TO DATE REPORTED IN THE BRA-ZILIAN STATE OF PERNAMBUCO IS SERIOUSLY THREATENING THE LIVES OF APPROXIMATELY 800,000 PEOPLE. THROUGHOUT THE STATE, TENS OF THOU-SANDS REMAIN UNSHELTERED, LOOKING FOR PROTECTION IN RAILROAD WAGONS, SCHOOLS AND ABANDONED BUILDINGS.

JORNAL DO BRAZIL REPORTED YESTERDAY THAT "IN RECIFE, EIGHTY PER CENT OF WHICH WAS FLOODED, HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE ARE DIGGING IN THE GARBAGE NOT ONLY FOR FOOD BUT FOR ANYTHING THAT CAN BE TRANSFORMED INTO MONEY. ...THE POORER SECTOR OF THE POPULATION IS FEEDING IT-SELF OFF DEAD ANIMALS IN ORDER TO SURVIVE."

JORNAL DO BRASIL STATES THAT "THE BLACK THREAT OF TYPHOID IS HOVERING OVER THE CITY." IN THE INTERIOR OF PERNAMBUCO AS WELL AS IN THE NEIGHBORING STATE OF ALAGOAS, ALSO SERIOUSLY HIT BY THE FLOODS, TYPHOID FEVER AND MEASLES ARE ALREADY SPREADING.

THE CITIES "RESEMBLE POST-WAR ITALY," SAYS THE JORNAL TODAY.

LODF PRESS CONFERENCE HELD IN FLINT

FLINT, MICHIGAN, JULY 26 (IPS) — MAY DEAN, NATIONAL BOARD MEMBER OF THE LABOR ORGANIZERS DEFENSE FUND (LODF), WILLIAM BRADEN, PRES-IDENT OF FLINT LOCAL FIRE FIGHTERS 352 AND EDGAR HOLT, VICE-PRESI-DENT OF THE GREATER FLINT AFL-CIO SPOKE TO THE PRESS HERE YESTERDAY IN PREPARATION FOR THE LAJOLLA-EVANS PRESIDENTIAL CAMPAIGN SWEEP THROUGH THE DETROIT AREA NEXT WEEK.

DEAN BRIEFED THE PRESS ON THE EXTENSIVE HARASSMENT OF LABOR PAR-TY ORGANIZING IN THE AREA AND NATIONALLY SAYING, "AN ATTACK ON THE LABOR PARTY IS AN ATTACK ON THE LABOR MOVEMENT." HE WAS SECONDED BY HOLT, WHO ADDED: "I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN IN THE FOREFRONT OF THE LABOR MOVEMENT AND IF THE LABOR PARTY IS THERE NOW, THEN I HAVE TO MOVE AS WELL."

NEYI-TV (CBS) AND WNEH-TV (NBC) Aired THE CONFERENCE ON LOCAL NEWS PROGRAMS. WFLD RADIO WAS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE CONFERENCE AS WELL.

ORDINATED PROVOCATEUR ATTACK. A MUSCULAR BLACK MAN JUMPED ONTO THE SPEAKER'S PLATFORM, ATTEMPTED TO DISRUPT THE CROWD AND WAS ESCORTED OFF BY USLP SECURITY OFFICERS. IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER A WHITE MAN WITH A BEARD, WHO HAS BEEN SEEN AT A LABOR PARTY RALLY RECENTLY, JUMPED OUT OF THE CROWD SHOUTING, "LET THE BLACK MAN SPEAK."

AS MAYORAL CANDIDATE NICK BENTON BEGAN TO BRIEF THE CROWD ON THE FBI MODUS OPERANDI THE PROVOCATEURS CHARGED THE PLATFORM. AFTER A SCUFFLE WHICH ALERTED POLICE, TWO OF THE AGENTS WERE ARRESTED ON CHARGES INCLUDING ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER.

SUBSEQUENTLY TWO OF THE ARRESTED AGENTS ADMITTED THAT THEY WERE ON METHADONE. A FULL INVESTIGATION WILL BE CARRIED OUT BY THE LABOR PARTY AND CHARGES WILL BE FORMALLY PRESSED WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO DISTRICT ATTORNEY.
