I. SPECIAL REPORT ON ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY

LAROCHE TO ARRIVE IN DETROIT TONIGHT AS HARASSMENT ESCALATES

OXFORD, OHIO, NOV. 15 (IPS)—LYNDON H. LAROCHE, U.S. LABOR PARTY CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, WILL LEAVE HERE FOR DETROIT TONIGHT AFTER ADDRESSING A CROWDED MIAMI UNIVERSITY PANEL FORUM ON "ZERO GROWTH: THE END OF PROGRESS."

MEANWHILE, ROCKEFELLER-ORDERED HARASSMENT OF THE USLP, CARRIED OUT BY THE FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION UNDER THE DIRECTION OF ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWARD LEVI, HAS INCREASED IN DETROIT, WHERE LAROCHE IS SCHEDULED TO ADDRESS A MICHIGAN STATE LABOR PARTY RALLY TOMORROW. LABOR PARTY RALLIES THROUGHOUT DETROIT THIS AFTERNOON WERE BESIEGED BY POLICE AND POLICE-RUN RADICAL COUNTERGANGS.

THE USLP HAS LEARNED THAT MEMBERS OF THE FBI-LED SOCIALIST WORKERS PARTY ARE COLLABORATING WITH THE FBI IN MAKING VISITS TO LOCAL BLACK LEADERS TO SLANDER THE USLP IN AN EFFORT TO INTIMIDATE THEM FROM MEETING LAROCHE. TWO NIGHTS AGO, THE SWP SABOTAGED A LABOR PARTY FORUM ON "WHATEVER HAPPENED TO INTEGRATION" AT HIGHLAND PARK COMMUNITY COLLEGE BY HOLDING A COUNTEREVENT IN SUPPORT OF THE ROCKEFELLER BUSING HOAX. SWP AGENTS REMOVED POSTERS ADVERTISING THE USLP FORUM AND CONSPIRED WITH THE COLLEGE ADMINISTRATION TO CLOSE THE BUILDING AT WHICH THE USLP EVENT WAS SCHEDULED TO BE HELD.

MAJOR PRESS BLACK-OUT OF ASSASSINATION THREAT BEGINS TO CRACK

NEW YORK, NOV. 15 (IPS)—AFTER TWO DAYS OF "HOLDING FOR FACT-CHECKING," UNITED PRESS INTERNATIONAL IN WASHINGTON, D.C. HAS RELEASED A STORY REPORTING THAT LYNDON H. LAROCHE, JR., U.S. LABOR PARTY PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE, WAS FORCED TO CANCEL A SAN FRANCISCO CAMPAIGN APPEARANCE AFTER THE USLP RECEIVED A THREATENING LETTER ALLEGEDLY WRITTEN BY CHARLES MANSON. THE STORY WAS TRANSMITTED YESTERDAY AFTERNOON ONLY TO UPI'S SAN FRANCISCO AREA, WHICH INCLUDES THE STATES OF WASHINGTON AND OREGON. THE FULL TEXT OF THE WIRE IS NOT KNOWN.

ALSO YESTERDAY, THE PORTLAND, OREGON, JOURNAL PUBLISHED A STORY ENTITLED "LABOR PARTY OFFICIALS ASK FOR POLICE PROTECTION." THE STORY DETAILED THE INTENSIFICATION OF HARASSMENT AGAINST THE USLP SINCE LAROCHE ANNOUNCED HIS INTENTION TO VISIT PORTLAND FOR A CAMPAIGN APPEARANCE AND REPORTED USLP CHARGES THAT VICE PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER IS BEHIND THE ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY.

OTHER COVERAGE OF THE ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY HAS INCLUDED TWO RADIO SPOTS ON CKLW AND WJLB RADIO IN DETROIT. CKLW IS THE LARGEST RADIO STATION IN THE MIDWEST AND CANADA.

IN A RELATED DEVELOPMENT, THE CHICAGO SUN-TIMES KILLED A STORY ON THE MANSON THREAT BY POLITICAL REPORTER JERRY WATSON. REACHED FOR COMMENT, SUN-TIMES EDITORIAL DIRECTOR EMMETT DUDMAN TOLD IPS "THERE'S A BIG DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FORD AND LAROUCHE. WE DON'T CARE ABOUT YOUR SPLINTER GROUP. YOU'RE PESTS TO OUR PEOPLE."

BUT, IPS HAS LEARNED, A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF REPORTERS AROUND THE COUNTRY ARE CALLING UPI TO ASK THAT THE UPI WIRE ON THE ASSASSINATION CONSPIRACY BE RELEASED NATIONWIDE.

II. INTERNATIONAL NEWS

MIKI CALLS FOR FUSION POWER DEVELOPMENT IN SPEECH TO PARIS ECONOMIC SUMMIT

NOV. 15 (IPS)—JAPANESE PRIME MINISTER TAKEO MIKI USED THE OCCASION OF HIS SPEECH TO THE PARIS ECONOMIC SUMMIT TODAY TO ISSUE A CALL FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF FUSION POWER, ACCORDING TO THE JAPANESE DAILY YOMIURI NOV. 12. MIKI CALLED FOR MEETING THE WORLD'S ENERGY PROBLEM THROUGH "INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION ON DEVELOPMENT OF FUSION POWER RESEARCH BETWEEN OIL-CONSUMING NATIONS." TERMING FUSION "A TOTALLY NEW SOURCE OF ENERGY," MIKI SAID THAT SINCE IT (ENERGY) IS AN INTERNATIONAL PROBLEM, WE SHOULD PROMOTE THE DEVELOPMENT OF IT UNDER INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION."

MIKI ALSO EXPRESSED SUPPORT FOR THE POLICY DISCUSSIONS AROUND THE DEBT MORATORIUM AND THE CREATION OF A NEW INTERNATIONAL LENDING AGENCY NOW UNDERWAY IN THE UNITED NATIONS COUNCIL ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT (UNCTAD). HE PLACED SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF ALL NATIONS COOPERATING TO EXPAND THE WORLD'S FOOD SUPPLY.

MIKI STATED THAT "EVEN THOUGH ASIA HAS AN EXTREMELY LARGE PORTION OF ITS POPULATION LIVING IN DIRE POVERTY, THE PER CAPITA DEVELOPMENT AID IS LOW....THE NATIONS OF ASIA IN THEIR CAPACITY WITHIN UNCTAD ARE TAKING A MUCH MORE MODERN APPROACH. IT IS HOPED THAT THIS APPROACH WILL BE GIVEN SUPPORT IN ORDER TO SOLVE NORTH-SOUTH PROBLEMS THROUGH COOPERATION. WE CALL UPON THE POSITIVE PARTICIPATION OF ALL NATIONS IN THE ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK IN THIS REGARD."

ISRAELI ECONOMIST CALLS FOR MORATORIUM ON NATIONAL DEBT

NOV. 15 (IPS)—GIVEN THE MAGNITUDE OF ISRAEL'S ECONOMIC CRISIS OUTLINED IN RECENT FINANCE MINISTRY REPORTS, "THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD DECIDE THAT DURING 1976 AND MAYBE 1977, NO BONDS WILL BE REDEEMED," JERUSALEM POST ECONOMIC REPORTER GIDION ESHET WRITES IN THE PAPER'S NOV. 12 EDITION.

IN AN ARTICLE ENTITLED "FINANCING INVESTMENTS THROUGH A MORATORIUM ON THE NATIONAL DEBT," ESHET ATTACKS GOVERNMENT PLANS TO CUT HUNDREDS OF MILLIONS OF DOLLARS FROM PLANNED INVESTMENTS AND EMPHASIZES THAT "INVESTMENTS WILL BE NEEDED EVEN MORE IN 1976 THAN TODAY." THIS IS ESPECIALLY SO SINCE "INVESTMENTS CREATE AN INCREASED CAPACITY TO PRODUCE MORE GOODS IN THE FUTURE."

TO FINANCE THE "NEEDED INVESTMENTS," ESHET INSISTS, THE GOVERNMENT SHOULD LOOK AT THE CURRENT OBLIGATION TO REDEEM ALMOST \$20 BILLION IN GOVERNMENT BONDS IN 1976. BY NOT REDEEMING THESE BONDS, ESHET STRESSES, "THE ADDITIONAL RESOURCES WILL BE FOUND. IT IS THE DUTY OF THE PRESENT GOVERNMENT," HE CONCLUDES, "TO CONVINCE THE PUBLIC THAT IN THESE DIFFICULT TIMES, A PARTIAL MORATORIUM ON THE NATIONAL DEBT IS THE CHEAPEST WAY OF RETURNING TO ECONOMIC WELL-BEING."

MAPAM PARTY DEFENDS ISRAELI STANDARD OF LIVING

NOV. 15 (IPS)--THE ISRAELI MINISTER OF HEALTH VICTOR SHEMTOV, A MEMBER OF THE PRO-SOCIALIST MAPAM PARTY, HAS PROPOSED A PROGRAM FOR EXPANDING SOCIAL WELFARE IN ISRAEL AT THE EXPENSE OF TAXATION ON CAPITAL AND FINANCIAL ASSETS, ACCORDING TO THE JERUSALEM POST OF NOV. 9. AT A HEATED CABINET DEBATE LAST WEEK ON THE QUESTION OF AUSTERITY, SHEMTOV CONDEMNED A GOVERNMENT PLAN TO ENACT "CONTROLLED UNEMPLOYMENT."

MINISTER OF HOUSING AVRAHAM OFER, AN ALLY OF U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT AGENTS MOSHE DAYAN AND DEFENSE MINISTER SHIMON PERES, HYSTERICALLY RESPONDED TO THE SHEMTOV PROPOSAL BY TERMING IT A "SOCIALIST REVOLUTION."

ANGOLAN FORCES THROW INVADERS ON DEFENSIVE ON SOUTHERN FRONT

NOV. 15 (IPS)--ANGOLAN ARMED FORCES HAVE FORCED A TANK COLUMN OF SOUTH AFRICAN AND NATO MERCENARIES WHO HAVE INVADED ANGOLA FROM NAMIBIA TO TAKE UP A DEFENSIVE POSITION IN FIGHTING ON THE SOUTHERN FRONT AROUND THE PORT OF BENGUELA, ACCORDING TO NEUES DEUTSCHLAND YESTERDAY. SIX OF THE MERCENARIES' 26 ARMORED VEHICLES HAVE BEEN DESTROYED, AND THE MERCENARIES HAVE REPORTEDLY TAKEN HEAVY CASUALTIES.

THE REPORT COINCIDES WITH SIGNIFICANT ADVANCES BY THE ANGOLAN FORCES ON THE FRONT NORTH OF LUANDA, WHERE THE ANGOLAN GOVERNMENT IS SEEKING TO REPULSE AN INVASION OF CIA-BACKED ZAIREAN FORCES AND "NATIONAL FRONT" MERCENARIES. THE ANGOLAN FORCES ARE ALSO CONTINUING THEIR ADVANCE ON THE CITY OF NOVA LISBOA IN CENTRAL ANGOLA, NOW THE SITE OF A RUMP, CIA-BACKED "RIVAL GOVERNMENT," ACCORDING TO THE LISBON DAILY DIARIO DE NOTICIAS NOV. 13.

INFLUENCE OF THE LEBANESE COMMUNIST PARTY SOARS

NOV. 15 (IPS)--THE INFLUENCE OF THE LEBANESE COMMUNIST PARTY (LCP) HAS GROWN ENORMOUSLY OVER THE PAST SEVERAL MONTHS OF FIGHTING IN LEBANON, ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S SUEDEDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG. THE ARTICLE REVIEWS THE LARGE AREAS OF THE COUNTRY WHICH HAVE SET

UP PEOPLE'S ADMINISTRATIONS FOLLOWING THE COLLAPSE OF LOCAL ADMINISTRATIONS LINKED TO THE DIVIDED AND AGENT-RIDDEN NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AND OBSERVES THAT OFFICIALS OF THE LEGAL LCP ARE ENTERING THESE PEOPLE'S ADMINISTRATIONS, FURTHERING THE GROWTH OF THE PARTY'S INFLUENCE.

SOVIETS HIT BOURGEOIS PRESS LIES

NOV. 15 (IPS)—THE SOVIET UNION'S LEADING POLITICAL COMMENTATOR, YURII ZHUKOV, HAS WRITTEN A MAJOR FEATURE IN PRAVDA NOV. 13 BLASTING THE WESTERN PRESS FOR DELIBERATE LYING IN ORDER TO SABOTAGE DETENTE, ACCORDING TO A REUTERS DISPATCH PRINTED IN THE NOV. 13 NEW YORK TIMES. ZHUKOV SINGLED OUT THE NEW YORK TIMES AND A SERIES OF FRENCH NEWSPAPERS FOR USING "THE NAZI PROPAGANDA TACTIC OF THE 'BIG LIE' WHEN WRITING ABOUT COMMUNIST COUNTRIES," ACCORDING TO THE REUTERS REPORT.

ZHUKOV PARTICULARLY HIT THE TIMES FOR "MAKING A FUSS AROUND PITIFUL RENEGADES SETTING THEMSELVES UP AGAINST SOCIETY AND THE SEARCH FOR ALLEGED 'CRACKS' IN THE STRENGTHENING UNITY OF THE PEOPLES OF THE FRATERNAL COUNTRIES."

ALSO NOV. 13, THE SOVIET MILITARY DAILY, KRASNAYA ZVEZDA, PUBLISHED A SATIRICAL PROFILE OF NEW YORK TIMES "MILITARY ANALYST" DREW MIDDLETON AS AN INTERNALLY TERRIFIED FANTASIZER WHO TARGETS PRO-DISARMAMENT CONGRESSMEN ON ORDERS FROM THE PENTAGON.

KRASNAYA ZVEZDA, COMMENTING ON MIDDLETON'S BOOK "WILL THE U.S. WIN THE NEXT WAR?", WHICH WORRIED THAT SOME "MAN IN THE WHITE HOUSE" MIGHT REFUSE TO PUSH THE NUCLEAR BUTTON, QUERIES WHETHER MIDDLETON MIGHT NOT BE GOING OVER THE BRINK PSYCHOLOGICALLY. MIDDLETON'S WRITINGS, SAYS THE PAPER, RECALL THE DEMISE OF POST-WAR U.S. DEFENSE SECRETARY FORRESTAL, WHO THREW HIMSELF OUT A WINDOW WITH A CRY OF "RUSSIAN TANKS." "WILL ANYONE SPREAD THE NET?", WHEN MIDDLETON TEETERS TOO FAR, ASKS KRASNAYA ZVEZDA—"THAT IS THE QUESTION."

AGENT DEFEATED IN BID FOR SPD EXECUTIVE SEAT

NOV. 15 (IPS)—RUDI ARNDT, THE COUNTERINSURGENT SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC MAYOR OF FRANKFURT, WEST GERMANY, WAS DEFEATED YESTERDAY IN HIS ATTEMPT TO WIN A SEAT ON THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY (SPD) AT THE SPD PARTY CONGRESS NOW UNDERWAY IN MANNHEIM, WEST GERMANY. OBSERVERS INTERPRETED ARNDT'S DEFEAT AS A SHOW OF STRENGTH BY PRO-DEVELOPMENT FORCES AROUND THE PARTY'S PARLIAMENTARY FRACTION LEADER HERBERT WEHNER, WHO REPORTEDLY LED THE OPPOSITION TO ARNDT.

ARNDT WAS ASSOCIATED WITH AGENT SPD CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT AND WAS A LEADER OF THE SO-CALLED FRANKFURT CIRCLE, A CENTER OF CORPORATIST AGENTS WHO HAVE USED THE ISSUES OF "CO-PARTICIPATION" AND "INVESTMENT CONTROL" IN AN ATTEMPT TO DISRUPT PRO-DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZING IN THE SPD. NEWS OF HIS DEFEAT WAS BROADCAST BY WEST GERMAN RADIO YESTERDAY.

PCI'S PAJETTA DELIVERS ANOTHER BLOW AGAINST USSR

NOV. 15 (IPS)--GIANCARLO PAJETTA, ONE OF THE HIGHEST RANKING CIA AGENTS LEADING THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI), DISCUSSED THE "CONSTRUCTION OF A SOCIALIST MODEL IN WESTERN EUROPE WHICH CAN IN NO WAY BE THAT EXISTENT IN THE EAST," IN AN INTERVIEW IN THE ITALIAN WEEKLY PANORAMA (THE EQUIVALENT OF THE U.S. TIME MAGAZINE). PAJETTA ALSO STATED THAT THIS "SOCIALIST MODEL" MUST BE BASED ON THE UNITY OF COMMUNISTS AND EUROPE'S AGENT-LED SOCIAL DEMOCRACIES.

PAJETTA FURTHER DECLARED THAT THIS WESTERN EUROPEAN SOCIALISM MUST FORCE DEMOCRATIZATION AND POLITICAL CHANGE IN THE EAST BLOC COUNTRIES. HE PARTICULARLY SINGLED OUT COMMUNIST CZECHOSLOVAKIA, SAYING THAT "WE CONSIDER WITH DEEP WORRIES AND WITH A CRITICISM WHICH WE HAVE NOT HIDDEN NOT ONLY EVENTS IN THE PAST OF THIS COUNTRY, BUT ALSO THE PRESENT SITUATION."

PAJETTA'S STATEMENTS FOLLOW BY ONLY TWO WEEKS SIMILAR COMMENTS BY SANTIAGO CARRILLO, CIA AGENT LEADER OF THE SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCE), PRINTED IN MANIFESTO, THE NEWSPAPER OF AN ITALIAN MAOIST COUNTERGANG OF THE SAME NAME. AT THAT TIME, THE PCI HAD CRITICIZED CARRILLO'S STATEMENTS ON THE GROUNDS THAT IT WAS PREMATURE TO OPENLY DISCUSS SUCH ANTI-SOVIET MATTERS.

SCHMIDT PROPOSES SDRS FOR THIRD WORLD; THIRD WORLD REJECTS OFFER

NOV. 15 (IPS)--WEST GERMANY'S SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT HAS ADVOCATED GIVING THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES MORE "SPECIAL DRAWING RIGHTS" OR "PAPER GOLD" FROM THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND SO THAT THEY CAN PURCHASE INDUSTRIAL GOODS FROM THE ADVANCED SECTOR. SCHMIDT MADE THE PROPOSAL AT THE INTERNATIONAL ROUNDTABLE DISCUSSION AT THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY CONGRESS NOW UNDERWAY IN MANNHEIM, WEST GERMANY.

DELEGATES ATTENDING THE CONFERENCE FROM MEXICO, VENEZUELA AND TANZANIA REJECTED SCHMIDT'S OFFER AND "ENERGETICALLY DEMANDED INSTEAD A NEW WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER," ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S SUEDE-DEUTSCHE ZEITUNG..

"SPECIAL DRAWING RIGHTS" WERE CREATED AT U.S. INSISTENCE IN THE LATE 1960S IN A FUTILE ATTEMPT TO PRESERVE THE INTEGRITY OF THE PRESENT WORLD DEBT STRUCTURE AND THE NOW-COLLAPSED BRETTON WOODS MONETARY SYSTEM.

III. CONTINENTAL NEWS

KISSINGER'S CONTACT WITH FORD RESTRICTED

NOV. 15 (IPS)--SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER HAS BEEN RESTRICTED TO LIMITED CONTACT WITH PRESIDENT FORD, FOLLOWING THE "HALLOWEEN MASSACRE" TWO WEEKS AGO, IN WHICH HE WAS REMOVED FROM HIS POST AS THE PRESIDENT'S NATIONAL SECURITY ADVISER, ACCORDING TO "NON-ATTRIBUTABLE LEAKS" QUOTED IN TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES.

KISSINGER NOW IS PERMITTED TO MEET WITH THE PRESIDENT ONLY WITH GROUPS OF OTHER AIDES, THE SOURCES SAID, ADDING THAT THE PRESIDENT IS PREPARING TO REPLACE HIM AT THE STATE DEPARTMENT HELM WITH CURRENT AMBASSADOR TO BRITAIN ELIOT RICHARDSON.

SYNDICATED COLUMNIST REFERENCES IPS QUESTION IN BLAST AT ROCKEFELLER, PRESS SYCOPHANTS

NOV. 15 (IPS)—SYNDICATED COLUMNIST GARY WILLS BLASTED THE PERFORMANCES OF VICE PRESIDENT ROCKEFELLER AND THE WASHINGTON PRESS CORPS AT ROCKEFELLER'S PRESS CONFERENCE LAST WEEK, WHERE THE VICE PRESIDENT EXPLAINED HIS DECISION TO REMOVE HIMSELF FROM THE 1976 REPUBLICAN TICKET. WILLS RIDICULED ROCKEFELLER'S EFFORTS TO PORTRAY THE MOVE AS A VOLUNTARY DECISION TAKEN FOR THE GOOD OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY AND PRESIDENT FORD, NOTING IN THE NOV. 13 WASHINGTON POST THAT "ROCKEFELLERS DO NOT LOSE; IF THEY LOSE, THEY CLAIM AGAINST ALL THE EVIDENCE THEY WERE NOT IN THE CONTEST."

NOTING THE PRESS REACTION TO AN IPS QUESTION TO ROCKEFELLER—ON THE CONSEQUENCES FOR HIS CABAL OF RECENT PRO-DEVELOPMENT MOVES BY CHICAGO-BASED INDUSTRIALISTS—WILLS OBSERVES: "THE REPORTERS GROANED AND SHOUTED, 'QUESTION!'...ACTUALLY, THAT IS THE REACTION THEY SHOULD HAVE SHOWN TO MR. ROCKEFELLER'S REPEAT PERFORMANCE AS A SORE LOSER CLAIMING HE HAD REALLY WON."

WEST GERMAN DEVELOPMENT SPOKESMAN SAYS SCHMIDT'S POSITION IS THAT OF UNCTAD ON IDB AND DEBT MORATORIA

WIESBADEN, BRD, NOV. 15 (IPS)—A SPOKESMAN FOR THE WEST GERMAN DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY TOLD INTERNATIONAL PRESS SERVICE TODAY THAT WEST GERMAN CHANCELLOR HELMUT SCHMIDT'S POSITION ON DEBT MORATORIA AND THE INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT BANK (IDB) IS THE SAME AS THE PROPOSALS PASSED IN FAVOR OF THESE MEASURES BY THE RECENT GENEVA MEETING OF THE UNITED NATIONS COUNCIL ON TRADE AND DEVELOPMENT (UNCTAD) FINANCE COMMITTEE. THE GENEVA MEETING CALLED FOR DEBT MORATORIA AND DEBT CANCELLATIONS FOR THIRD WORLD NATIONS AND FOR CREATION OF A MULTILATERAL AGENCY TO CONVERT SHORT-TERM THIRD WORLD DEBT INTO LONG-TERM DEBT AND TO ISSUE NEW DEVELOPMENT CREDITS.

INDICATING THAT SCHMIDT HAS SO FAR ONLY APPROVED DEBT MORATORIA FOR INDIVIDUAL COUNTRIES, THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT "IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR SCHMIDT TO MOVE INTO A DIFFERENT LEVEL," WITH A POSITION SIMILAR TO UNCTAD'S, WHEN HE GOES TO THE UPCOMING DECEMBER MEETING OF OIL-PRODUCING AND ENERGY-CONSUMING COUNTRIES IN PARIS.

S. 1 PASSAGE BY SENATE "VIRTUALLY CERTAIN," OPPONENT CHARGES

NEW YORK, NOV. 15 (IPS)—SENATE BILL ONE (S. 1), A THOROUGH-GOING FASCIST REVISION OF THE U.S. CRIMINAL CODE, IS VIRTUALLY CERTAIN TO BE APPROVED BY THE SENATE WITHIN THE NEXT THREE WEEKS, A LEADING OPPONENT OF THE BILL CHARGED IN A SPEECH HERE TODAY.

FRANK WILKINSON OF THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE AGAINST REPRESSIVE LEGISLATION LAID THE BLAME FOR THE BILL'S EXCELLENT CHANCE OF PASSAGE ON THE NATIONAL PRESS, WHICH HAS VIRTUALLY BLACKED OUT COVERAGE OF S. 1 DURING THE CRITICAL PERIOD BEFORE IT COMES UP FOR FINAL MARK-UP IN THE SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, AND THREE LEADING SENATE "LIBERALS," SENATORS HUBERT HUMPHREY (D-MINN) AND BIRCH BAYH (D-IND) AND FORMER SENATOR SAM ERVIN (D-NC).

S. 1 IS DESIGNED TO GIVE EX POST FACTO LEGALIZATION TO MCCARTHY ERA STYLE REPRESSIVE MEASURES WHICH HAVE ALREADY BEEN WIDELY USED BY POLICE AGENCIES UNDER THE DIRECTION OF ATTORNEY GENERAL EDWARD LEVI IN ATTEMPTS TO WRECK THE ORGANIZING OF THE U.S. LABOR PARTY. S. 1 SUBSTANTIVELY RE-ENACTS THE OLD MCCARTHY PERIOD LEGISLATION AGAINST "SUBVERSIVES" IN THE UNITED STATES, WITH EVEN MORE STRINGENT PROHIBITIONS AGAINST POLITICAL ORGANIZING. THE ACT WOULD ALSO PROTECT THE CIA AND OTHER ROCKEFELLER TERROR AGENCIES FROM REVELATION AND PROSECUTION OF THEIR ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES, UNDER THE RUBRIC OF "NATIONAL SECURITY."

WILKINSON WARNED AGAINST FACILE ACCEPTANCE OF SEN. BAYH'S REPUDIATION OF S. 1 AND WARNED THAT BAYH, ALONG WITH HUMPHREY AND FORMER SEN. ERVIN, "HAD TO BE WATCHED."

HUMPHREY HAS A LONG HISTORY OF SUPPORT FOR FASCIST LEGISLATION, HAVING PERSONALLY STEERED MOST OF THE ORIGINAL MCCARTHY ERA LEGISLATION AFTER WHICH S. 1 IS MODELED THROUGH CONGRESS IN THE 1950S. INCLUDED AMONG THESE REPRESSIVE BILLS WAS LEGISLATION TO LOCK UP "SUBVERSIVES" IN CONCENTRATION CAMPS.

TWO MONTHS AGO, UNDER PRESSURE OF NATIONWIDE CAMPAIGNS AGAINST THE BILL BY THE U.S. LABOR PARTY AND OTHER FORCES, MANY LEADING PAPERS IN THE COUNTRY, INCLUDING EVEN SOME WHICH ARE PRO-ROCKEFELLER, CALLED FOR THE DEFEAT OF S. 1 AND PRINTED ARTICLES EXPOSING THE BILL'S UNCONSTITUTIONAL PROVISIONS. MORE RECENTLY, HOWEVER, THE PRESS OPPOSITION TO S. 1 HAS ALL BUT VANISHED.

IN A PREVIEW OF S. 1 TYPE PROSECUTIONS, ATTORNEY GENERAL LEVI IS PRESENTLY PREPARING "SUBVERSION" CASES AGAINST THE USLP AND NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES UNDER THE SMITH AND MCCARRAN ACTS.
